

The Health Law Society By-Law for 2011-2012

The Health Law Society is a validly chartered SBA group.

A member of the Albany Law School community becomes a member by signing up for the e-mail list.

The Health Law Society only allows active members to vote in group elections.

A member of the Health Law Society becomes an active member by attending at least 1 meeting per year and signing up for the e-mail list.

In order to stay active, an active member must stay on the e-mail list and contribute to the functioning of the society.

If a member removes him/herself from e-mail list, he or she loses active member status in the Health Law Society.

The Health Law Society holds meetings at least once a semester.

The President shall call a meeting of the Health Law Society, and if fails to do so the VP, Secretary, or Treasurer may do so.

The Health Law Society holds elections every year at the end of April. The new e-board takes over leadership at the beginning of the next school year.

A member of the Health Law Society becomes eligible to run for office, by being an active member for 2 weeks and by submitting his/her intention to run for office to the current e-board within the week preceding the election.

An officer of the Health Law Society may be impeached for failing in his or her duties. An active member of the Health Law Society may call for the impeachment of an officer. If 3/4 of the active members vote in favor of impeachment, the officer is thereby impeached, and a new election for the vacant position must be held.

Duties of the officers of the Health Law Society are as follows.

- President
 - call the meetings,
 - head the meetings,
 - organize activities
 - be the liason for contacts with other student groups

- VP
 - help the president
 - organize activities
 - focus on outreach/connections

- Treasurer
 - keep track of funds
 - fundraise & aid the social chair
 - create budget

- Secretary
 - take notes at all meetings & deliver them to the e-board
 - maintain all pertinent records

- Social Chair
 - organize social events

- be the point in fundraising events
