

The Hellenic Society By-Laws for 2011-2012.

The Hellenic Society is a validly chartered SBA chartered SBA group.

A member of the Albany Law School community becomes a member of the Hellenic Society by attending meetings and signing up for the email list.

The Hellenic Society only allows active members to vote in group elections and decisions.

In order to stay active, an active member must attend 1 meeting or event per semester and stay on the email list.

If a member removes himself/herself from the email list and/or does not attend any meetings/events and does not communicate his/her desire to remain a part of the Hellenic Society, he or she will lose active member status.

The Hellenic Society holds meetings on an ad need basis, with a minimum of 1 general meeting per semester.

Any member of the Executive Board may call a meeting of the Hellenic Society.

The Hellenic Society calls elections twice a year; once during the first semester to elect 1L representatives, and once the second semester to elect the e-board for the following year. The new e-board takes over leadership at the time of the election.

The Hellenic Society holds elections at a scheduled election meeting.

In order to win an election, a candidate of the Hellenic Society must secure the majority of the votes cast.

A member of the Hellenic Society becomes eligible to run for office by being an active member and by submitting his/her intention to run for office to the current e-board at any time prior to the casting of votes.

Duties of the officers of the Hellenic Society are as follows:

#### President

- Call and head meetings
- Determine the events that will be held by the club
- Organize events
- Determine what should be included in the budget and submit to SMA
- Communications with the SBA reps
- Help fundraise

#### Vice President

- Take meeting minutes
- Coordinate marketing of events to the student body

- Held fundraiser
- Offer input as to which events/fundraisers the club should undertake
- Assist the president with organizing events

#### Treasurer

- Keep track of funds
- Help fundraiser
- Writes the budget

#### Secretary

- Take meeting minutes
- Help fundraiser
